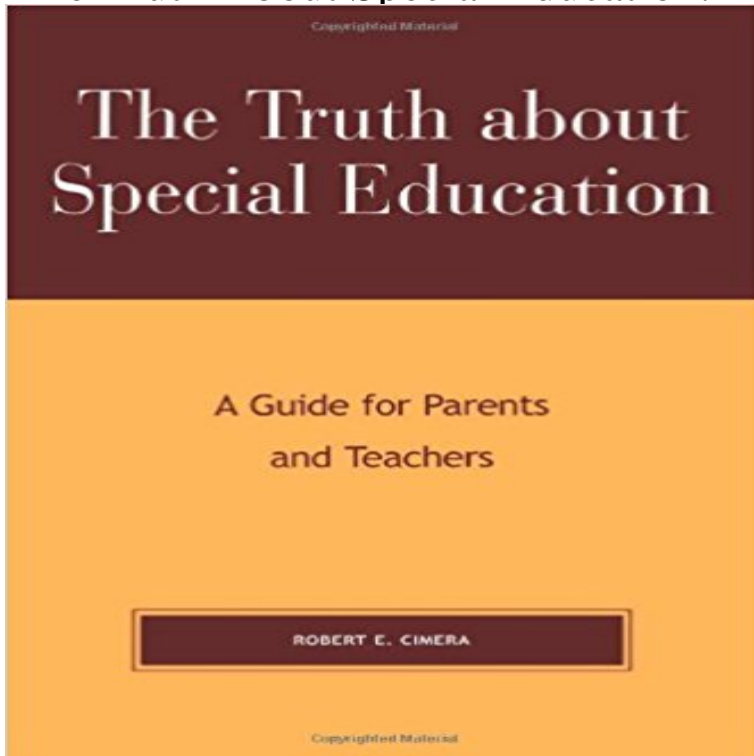


The Truth About Special Education: A Guide for Parents and Teachers
