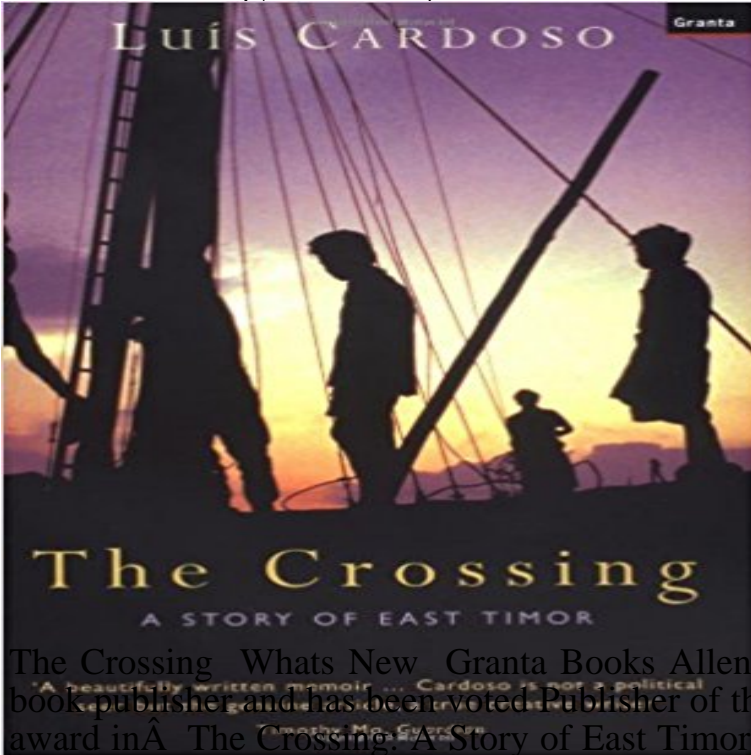


# The Crossing: A Story of East Timor
