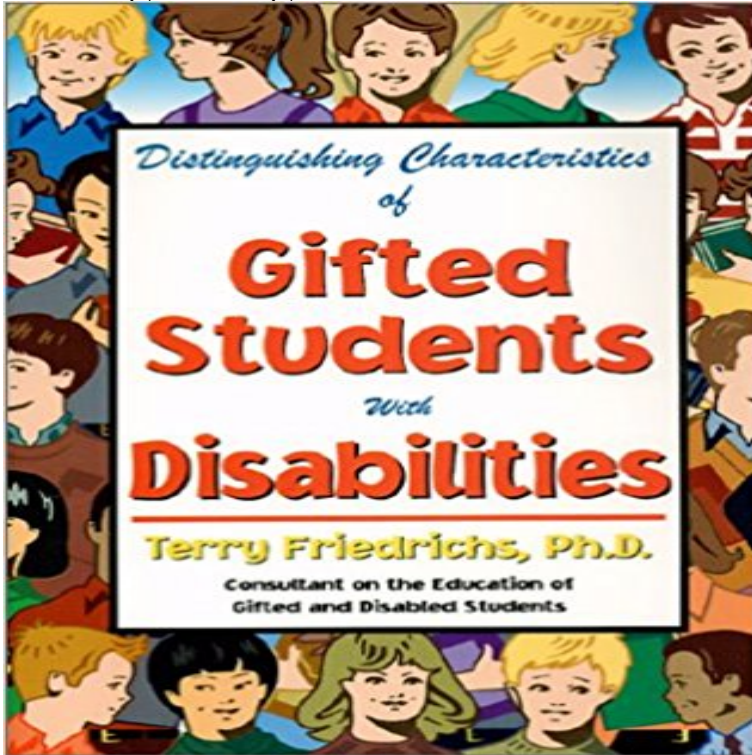


Distinguishing Characteristics of Gifted Students With Disabilities
