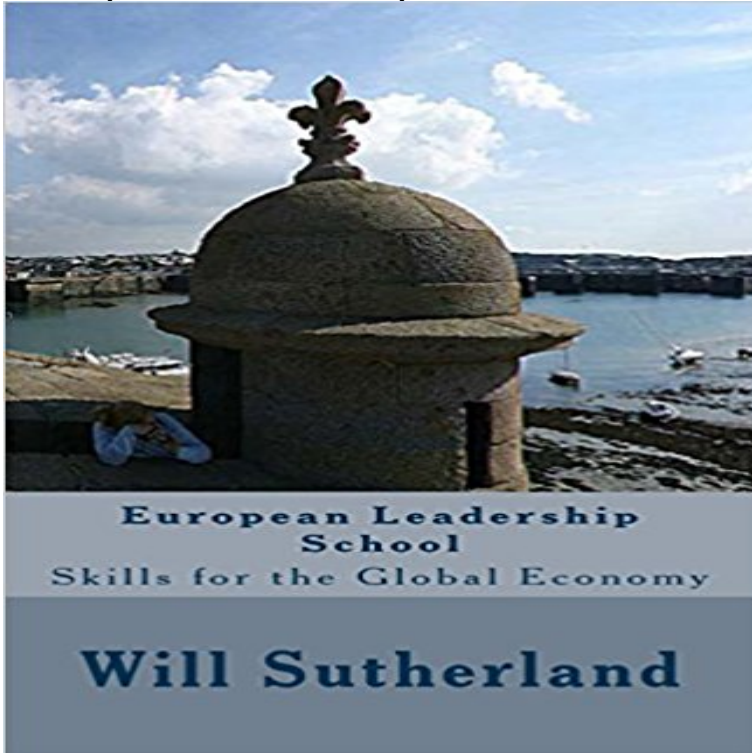


European Leadership School: Skills for the Global Economy
