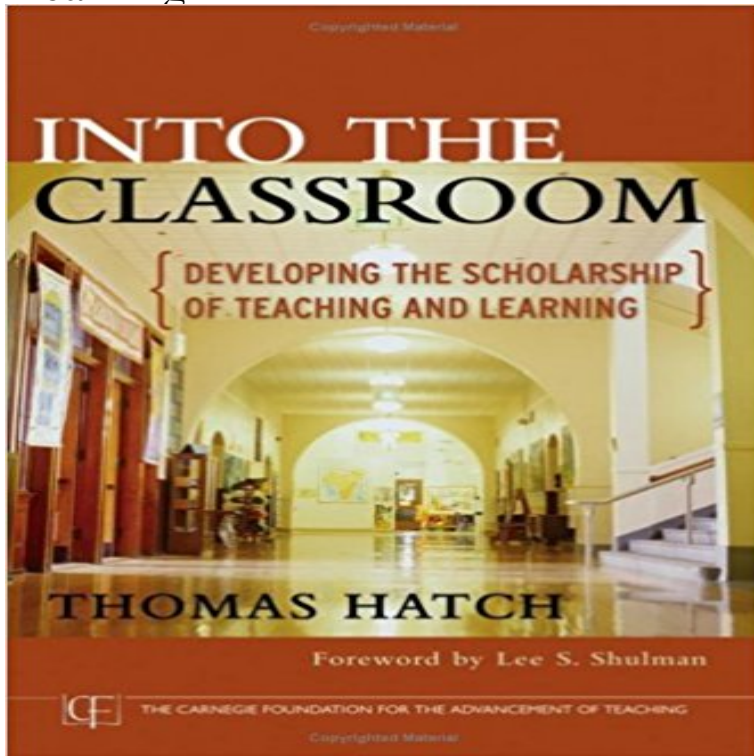


Into the Classroom: Developing the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning
