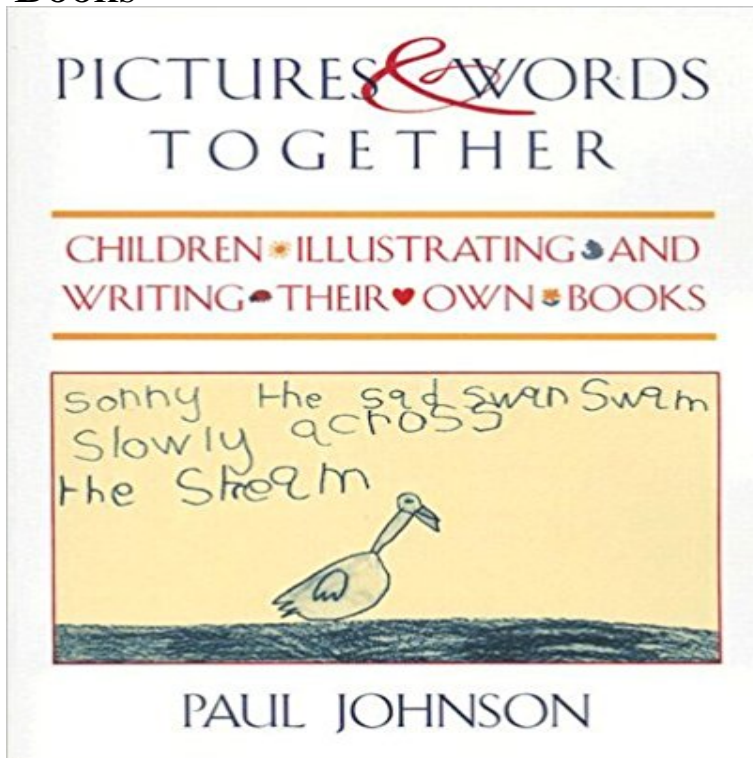


# Pictures & Words Together: Children Illustrating and Writing Their Own Books
