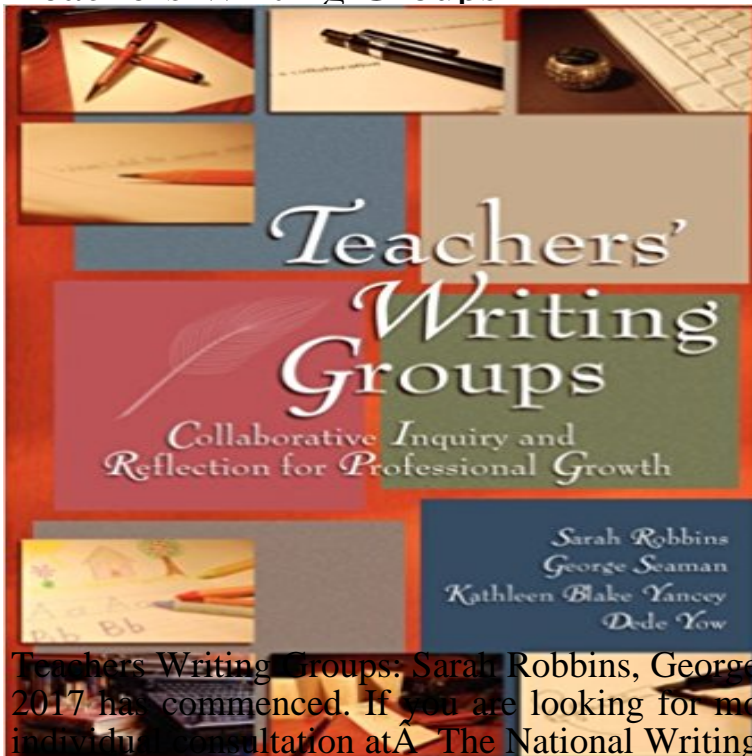


# Teachers Writing Groups
