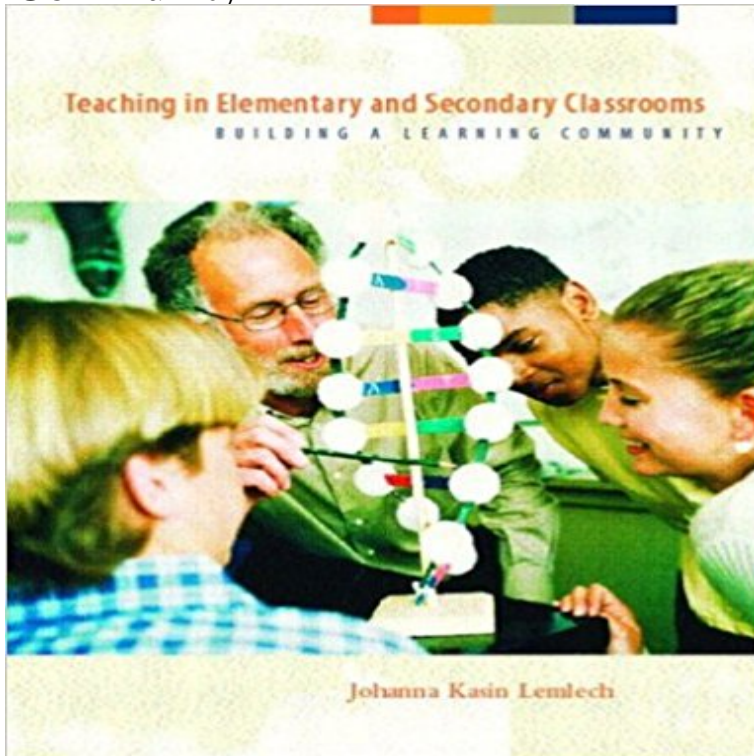


# Teaching in Elementary and Secondary Classrooms: Building a Learning Community
