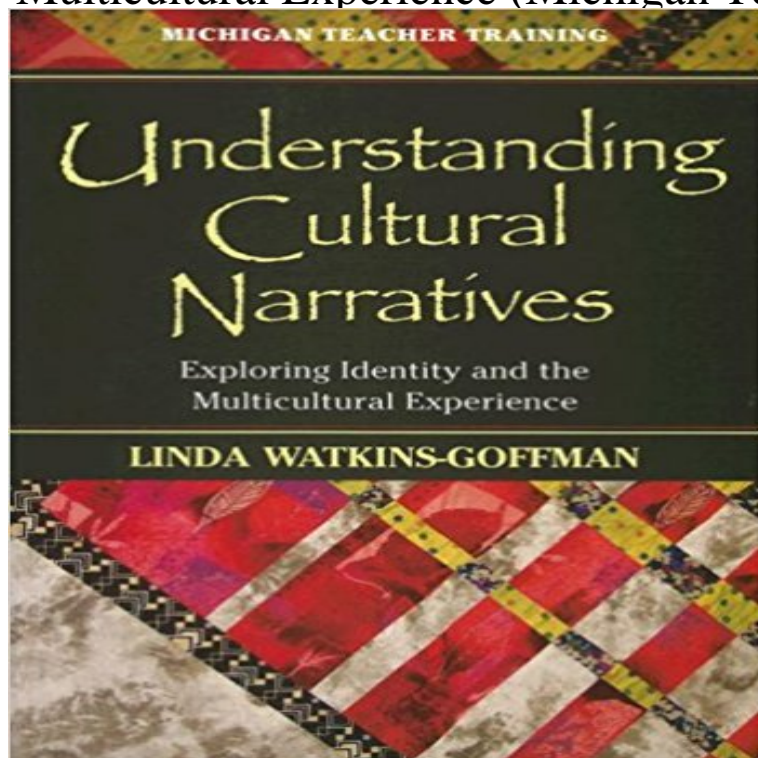


Understanding Cultural Narratives: Exploring Identity and the Multicultural Experience (Michigan Teacher Training (Paperback))
