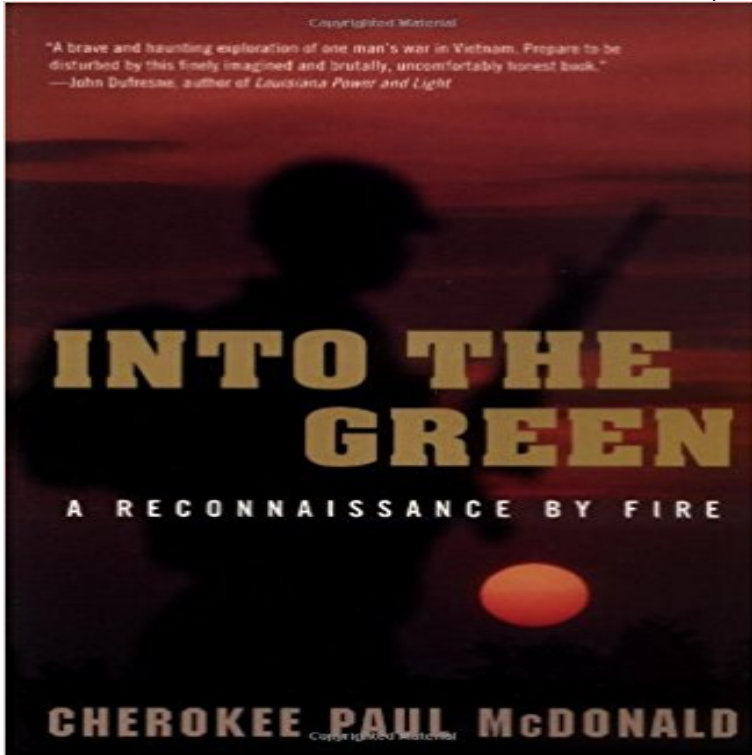


Into the Green: A Reconnaissance by Fire

McDonald tells his story in the voice of memory; as a writer looking back.
