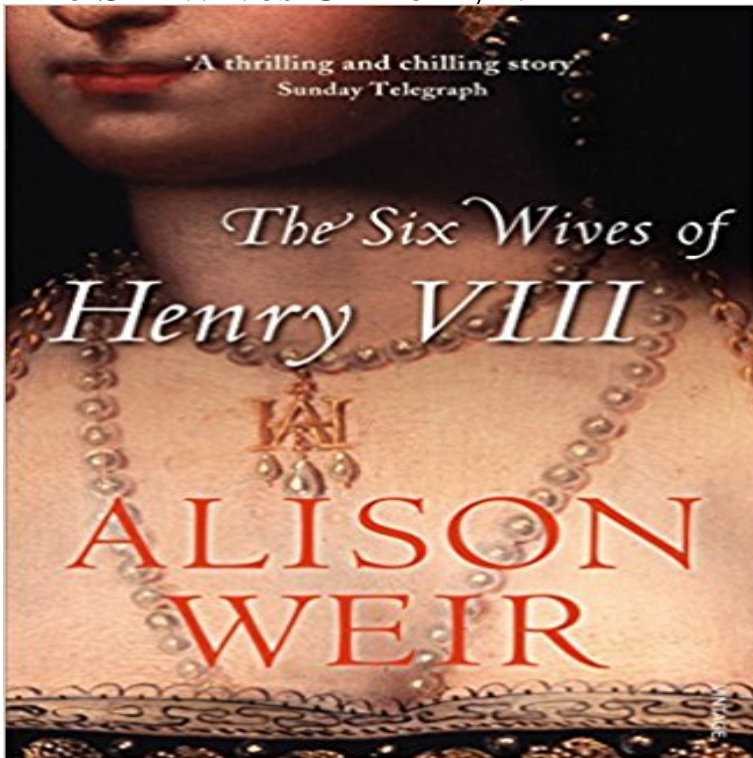


The Six Wives Of Henry VIII
