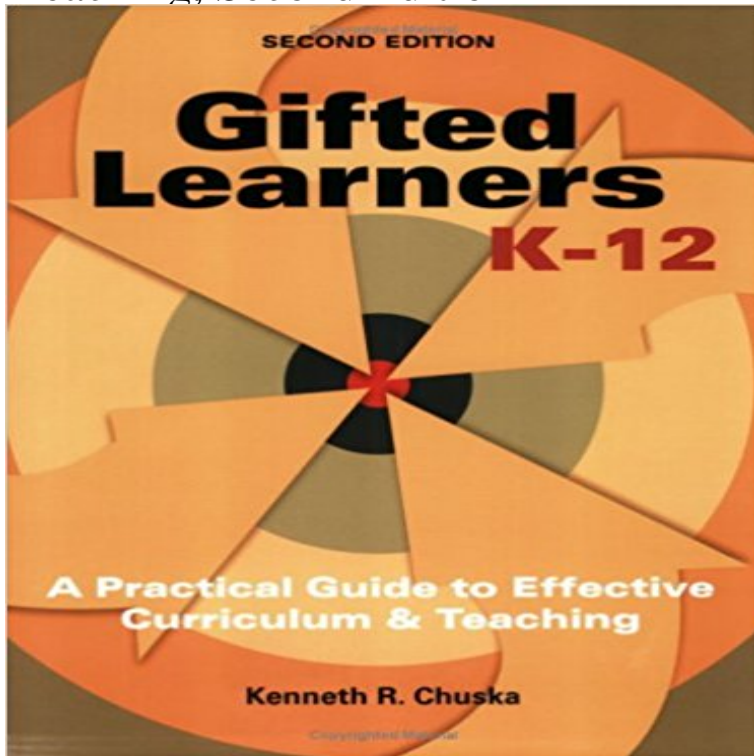


# Gifted Learners K-12: A Practical Guide to Effective Curriculum and Teaching, Second Edition
