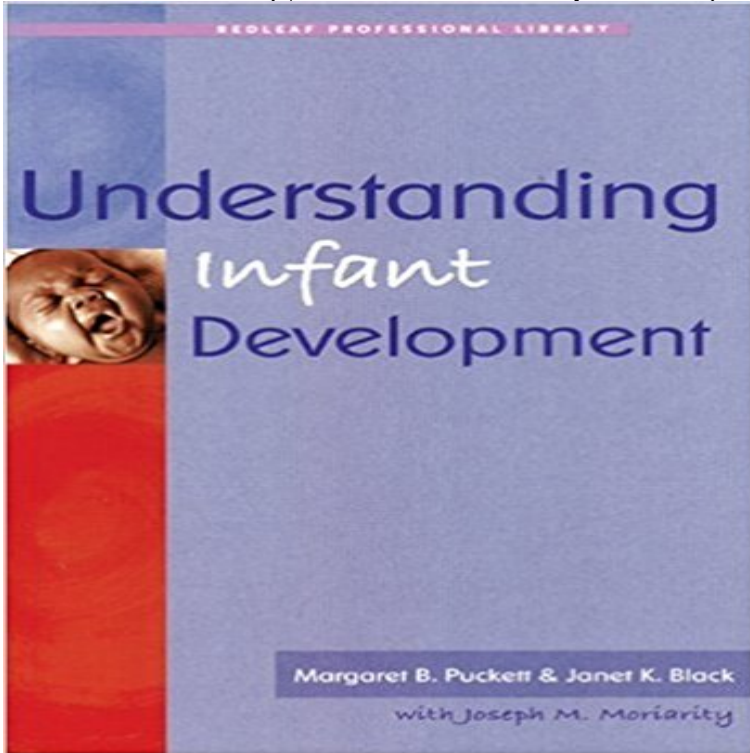


Understanding Infant Development (Redleaf Professional Library)
