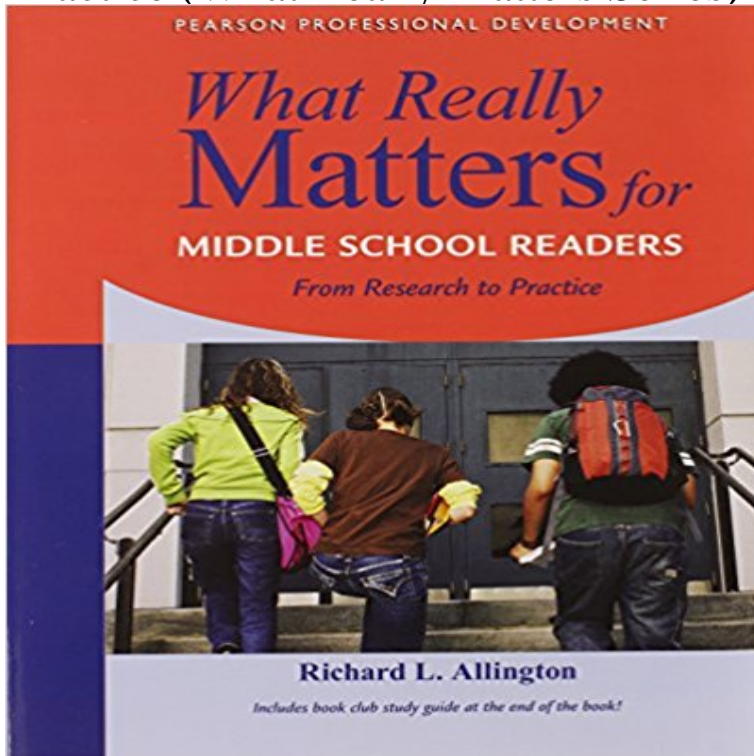


What Really Matters for Middle School Readers: From Research to Practice (What Really Matters Series)
