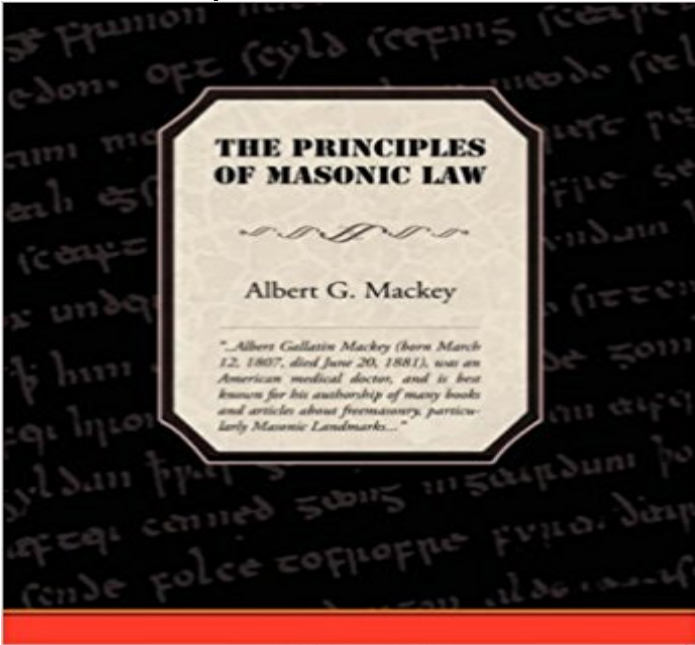


# The Principles of Masonic Law
