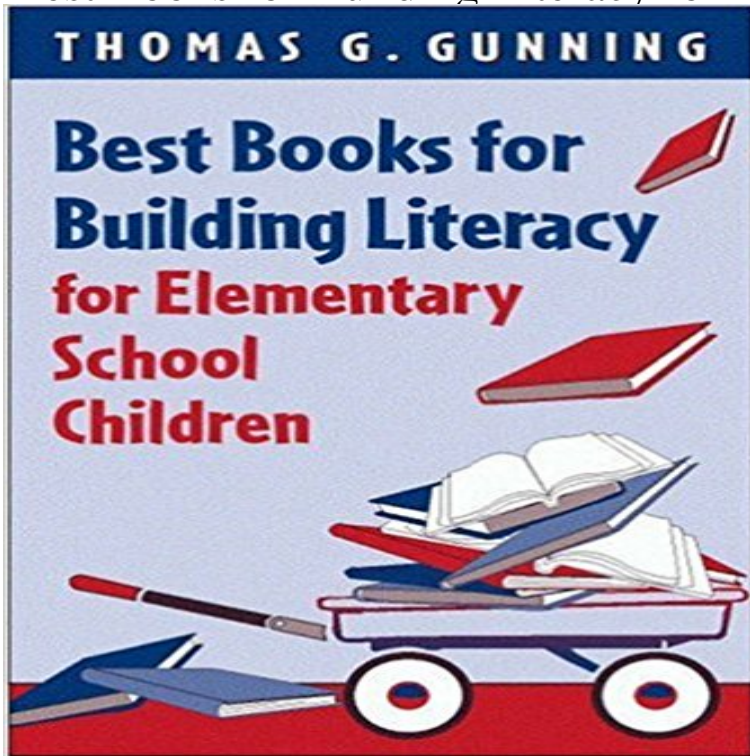

A special effort was made to include books that students reading below grade level would be able to handle. All annotations include a summary of each book, and many provide suggestions for using a particular book to foster comprehension, vocabulary, or writing development. Numerous suggestions for tie-ins with science, history, and other content

areas are also included. To help readers locate a particular book, the books are indexed by author, by title, and by the skill that is reinforced in the book.
