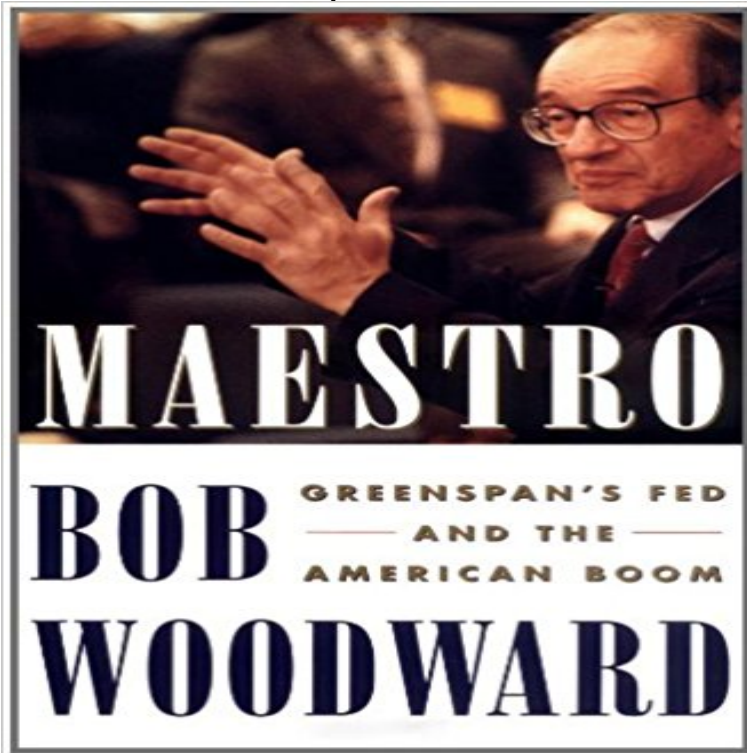


Maestro: Greenspan's Fed And The American Boom
