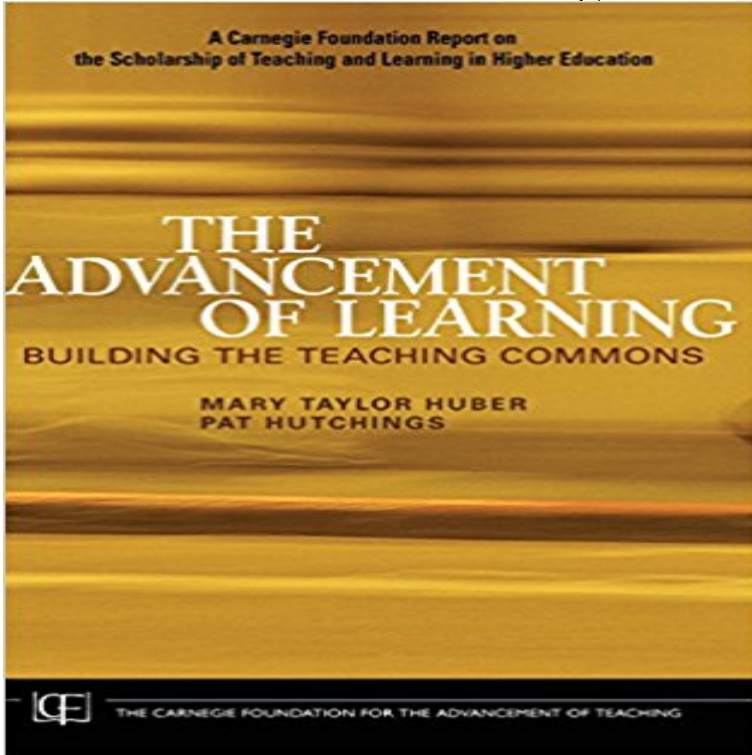


The Advancement of Learning: Building the Teaching Commons
