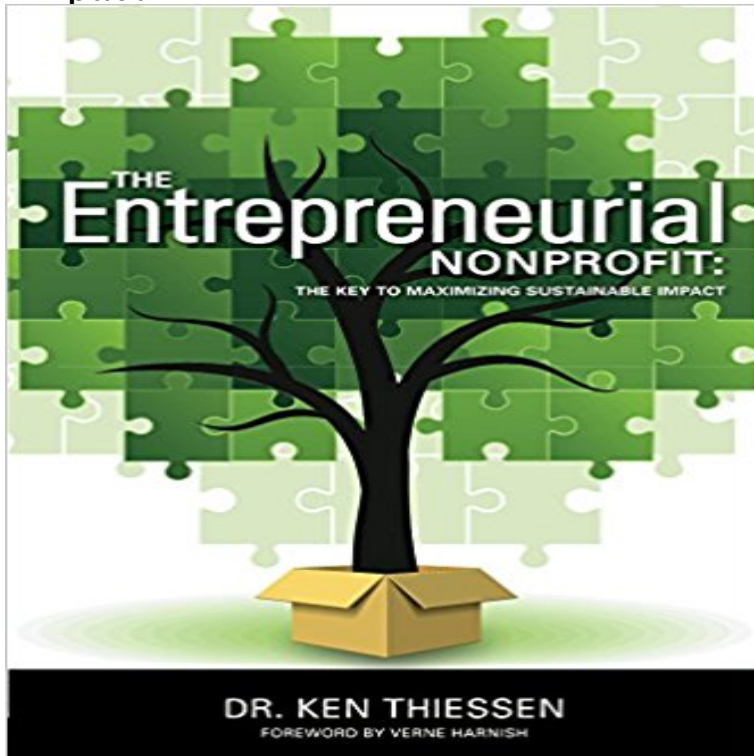


The Entrepreneurial Non-Profit: The Key to Maintaining Sustainable Impact
